D) Read and study singular and plural forms of nouns

Topic – 3: Singular and plural forms of nouns

There are six different methods of converting singular nouns in to plurals.

1. By adding “s” to the singular

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Student	Students
Tree	Trees
Egg	Eggs

2. Nouns ending with “ch”, “s”, “sh”, “x” and “ish” form their plurals by adding “es”.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Watch	Watches
Glass	Glasses
Brush	Brushes
Fox	Foxes
Dish	Dishes

3. Nouns ending with “y” form their plurals by changing “y” to “ies”.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
City	Cities
Baby	Babies
Fly	Flies
Lady	Ladies
Country	Countries

4. Nouns ending with “o” form their plurals in two ways, (by adding “s” & by adding “es”).

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Photo	Photos
Dynamo	Dynamos
Mango	Mangoes
Tomato	Tomatoes

5. Nouns ending with “f” or “fe” form their plurals by changing “f” in to “ves”

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Wife	Wives
Knife	Knives
Thief	Thieves
Leaf	Leaves

6. Irregular Nouns:

Some nouns form their plurals by changing their spelling or remaining as they are.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Child	Children

Ox	Oxen
Man	Men
Woman	Women
Tooth	Teeth
Goose	Geese
Foot	Feet
Sheep	Sheep
Deer	Deer
