A) Read and study singular and plural nouns (Regular).

Topic – 1: Singular and plural forms of nouns

There are six different methods of converting singular nouns in to plurals.

1. Normally the plural of nouns is formed by adding “s” to the singular.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Tree	Trees
Brother	Brothers

2. Nouns ending with “ch”, “s”, “sh”, “x” and “ish” form their plurals by adding “es”.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Glass	Glasses
Dish	Dishes
Bus	Buses

Note: Most nouns ending with ‘o’ also form the plural by adding ‘es’.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Potato	Potatoes
Tomato	Tomatoes

Note: Some nouns ending with two vowels form their plural by adding only 's'.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
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Toe	Toes
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Radio	Radios
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Idea	Ideas
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3. Nouns ending with "y" form their plurals by changing "y" to "ies".

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
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Baby	Babies
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Lady	Ladies
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Country	Countries
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Note: Nouns ending in 'y' following a vowel letter form their plural by adding 's'.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
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Boy	Boys
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Toy	Toys
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4. Nouns ending with "f" or "fe" form their plurals by changing "f" in to "ves"

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
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Wife	Wives
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Knife	Knives
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Thief	Thieves
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Leaf	Leaves
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Irregular Nouns:

Some nouns form their plurals by changing the spelling of their singulars.

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Child	Children
Tooth	Teeth
Goose	Geese
Man	Men
Foot	Feet
Woman	Women
Mouse	Mice
Person	People
Criterion	Criteria

Note: The plural forms of some nouns can be the same as their singular forms

Examples

<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Sheep	Sheep
Deer	Deer
Fish	Fish
